Rules:

-Please see and follow "Attention All Horsemen".

-Every exhibitor is required to forward with their entry form a certificate of proof of liability insurance for the current year (minimum of \$1,000,000 is required), membership fee, and a copy of negative Coggins test within the period of two years preceding the first day of the Fair is recommended. Entries will not be processed until this information is received and will be subject to late entry fee of 25% of gross prize money. Entries are to be sent to Pontiac Agricultural Society, Box 149, Shawville QC J0X 2Y0. Entries must be received in the Fair office or postmarked by August 30th 2021.

-Entry fee: 15% of prize money won by exhibitor.

-Stall fee of \$5.00 will be deducted from prize money.

-All driven entries **must** have another capable driver with them.

-Please print clearly on entry form.

-Use correct exhibitor number for each animal, to avoid errors with results.

-Hitch horses have priority in the heavy horse barn.

-Due to the volume of animals, loading and unloading will be at the side and back of the heavy horse barn.

-Passes are allotted as: helper – 1 pass for every 2 horses; vehicle – 2 passes for 6 horses, maximum of 3, the second and third vehicles must park off-site. Passes will be distributed after animals have been checked in by the Director.

-Pontiac Agricultural Society may have to limit exhibitors due to space constraints.

-All exhibitors should arrive 3 hours prior to the show start time. If this is not possible, please contact the PAS office or the PAS Division Director.

-Due to the limited parking, spaces will be assigned. Please see the parking attendant before parking.

COVID RULES

All exhibitors, helpers and spectators must respect guidelines from Santé publique du Québec. The COVID rules for the show details are **subject to approval and recommendation from Santé publique du Québec. We will keep you updated in a timely manner** of any changes to these rules.

- **We recommend** that you and your helpers **get your second dose of vaccine** at least two weeks **before the Shawville Fair.**
- **We will be respecting all social distancing rules as required in the barns and show ring.**
- **Exhibitors must provide names and contact information for all helpers.**
- Barns are closed to the general public.
- In order to allow the most distance between individuals, **all exhibitors are asked not to store feed, bedding, implements or chairs in the walkways or in front of the barn doors.**
- **Due to the exceptional nature of this year, it will be a limited show with different classes**

Be prepared for all kinds of weather**

Classes and PRIZES:

The exhibitors starting with six and completing all the remaining classes will get paid 1 500\$

The exhibitors starting with four and completing all the remaining classes will get paid 1 200\$

If they do not show in all the classes, money will be deducted

Class 51 Six horses hitch

Class 48 Four horses hitch

Class 45 Unicorn hitch

Class 40 Open team

Class 12 Ladies team

Class 30 Junior team under 18 paid at the end of the show.

Prize will be First 90, second 80 third 70 and 60 to the end but class will only be done if there are three entries.
