

ATTENTION ALL BEEF EXHIBITORS

- Open to exhibitors from all regions
- All exhibitors must become members of the Pontiac Agricultural Society
- **Every exhibitor is required to forward with their entry form a certificate of proof of liability insurance for the current year (minimum of \$2,000,000 is required) and membership fee. Entries are to be sent to Pontiac Agricultural Society, Box 149, Shawville QC J0X 2Y0. Entries must be received in the Fair office or postmarked by August 18, 2023. Entires on AssitExpo by August 25, 2023.**
- Entry fee: 15% of prize money won by the exhibitor.
- Protests shall be lodged with the Director of the division or the Fair office on the day of show. All protests must be made in writing and accompanied by \$100.00 cash or a certified cheque payable to Pontiac Agricultural Society. The director's decision is final. No protest shall impede the schedule of the show or flow of classes.
- It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Pontiac Agricultural Society and/or the committee blameless for any loss or accident. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall be responsible for any injury or damage that may be occasioned to any person or thing whomever or whatever against all claims or demands for loss or damage occasioned thereby.
- Children under the age of 6 years will not be allowed in any of the livestock buildings unless accompanied by an adult.
- Animals showing signs of contagious diseases or parasite infections – i.e. IBR, lice, will not be allowed to remain on the grounds.
- Pontiac Agricultural Society is not liable for any diseases passed from animals at the Fair.
- All animals must have Quebec ATQ tags or Ontario identification tags. If an animal does not have proper identification tags, the animal in question will be asked to leave the grounds.
- Passes are allotted as: helper – 2 pass for every 4 head; vehicle – 1 pass per exhibitor, over 6 head 2nd vehicle pass is off-site. Passes will be distributed after animals have been checked in by the Director.
- A maximum of 10 classes per breed to be shown
- Two substitutions will be allowed
- There are no restrictions on multiple exhibits in any classes, excluding the breeders herd and get of sire and progeny of dam.
- The number of entries per exhibitor is limited to a maximum 10.
- Calves shown in cow/calf pairs may be shown individually

- Any Other Breeds and Crossbreed may enter all classes.
- Ribbons will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners and Champion Classes.
- Banners given to all Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion in every breed. Chairs are awarded for Supreme Male and Supreme Female.
- For Friday arrival, please inform Directors by Wednesday morning.
- Exhibitors arrive Saturday morning and leave when show is finished.
- The show order may change due to the number of entries but will be in alphabetical order. One breed class after the other i.e; Angus, Bull calf, Any Other Breed or Crossbreed, Bull calf, etc
- Prior to set-up of clipping crates, please contact the Director in charge as to the correct location.
- No bedding of stalls is allowed until the barn superintendent has allotted them.
- Any classes with more than 14 entries may be split at judges discretion.

9. MATURE COW born prior January 1st, 2021 with her own 2023 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Female and calf shall be shown as a unit, except that the calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in classes 1, 4, 10, 11 & 12.

10. BREEDER'S HERD - A group of four (4) animals bred by the exhibitor, both sexes represented, must have shown in previous classes. At least one (1) animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one (1) exhibit per exhibitor.
11. GET OF SIRE -A group of three (3) animals from the same sire, both sexes represented, must have shown in previous classes. At least one (1) animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one (1) exhibit per exhibitor.
12. PROGENY OF DAM Two (2) animals the progeny of one dam, must have been shown in previous classes. Limited to one (1) exhibit per exhibitor.
