Rules:

-Every exhibitor is required to forward with their entry form a certificate of proof of liability insurance for the current year (**minimum of \$2,000,000 is required**), membership fee, and a copy of **Coggins or EH E-1 vaccination proof is mandatory**. Entries will not be processed until this information is received, and will be subject to late entry fee of 25% of gross prize money. Entries are to be sent to Pontiac Agricultural Society, 215 Lang St. , Box 149, Shawville QC J0X 2Y0. Entries must be received in the Fair office, by email or AssistExpo postmarked by August 21st, 2023. ALL ENTRIES AFTER THAT DATE WILL NOT BE PROCESS!!!

-Entry fee: 15% of prize money won by exhibitor.

-Stall fee of 5\$ will be deducted of prize money.

-All entries must be completely filled out, including the animal's name and name of rider/driver and be signed.

-The stalls will be allotted on a first come first serve basis. NO RESERVATIONS.

-Only one entry form is to be used for each exhibitor. If more forms are required, call the Fair office at 819-647-3213 or photocopy.

-Exhibitors may bring in animals after 8:00 p.m. Saturday night.

-Exhibitors may pick up their show ring number(s) or make any entry changes on the morning of Sunday, September 3rd from 8:30 a.m. to noon in the designated area.

-No cross entering will be allowed. Horses or ponies entered in one division cannot show in any other division except in the "Special Classes".

-All horses and ponies are subject to measurement which will be made in accordance with the C.E.F. rules and regulations.

-Stallions are not eligible in any ladies or children's classes.

-To be eligible for entry in a stake class, the animals must have been entered, shown and judged in at least one other class in the division in which the stake is offered.

-No classes will be changed or moved and will be judged in the order as they appear in this book.

-All exhibitors and attendants must be neatly and appropriately attired upon entering the ring.

-Joint ownership is permitted in pair classes.

-Each exhibitor is subject to and should be familiar with the by-laws of the Pontiac Agricultural Society, which are found in this book and with all the horsemen rules found at the beginning of the horse section.

-Working trailers may only be parked in the area designated by the Director. Trailer space will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

-Passes are allotted as: helper – 1 pass for 4 or more horses; vehicle – 1 pass for 4 horses, maximum of 2, the second vehicle must park off-site. Passes will be distributed after animals have been checked in by the Director.

-Due to the limited parking, spaces will be assigned. Please see the parking attendant before parking.

Classes :

All other classes are limited to 15 riders. First come, first served, as per time and date of email, AsssitExpo or post mark.

21. Novice (PeeWee) Western Equitation - rider 9 years old or younger, must be accompanied by an adult and the horse/poney to be 14 hands and under.

22. Youth Western Equitation – Rider 10 years old or older.

23. Adult Western Equitation – Rider 18 years old or older.

24. Novice (PeeWee) Western Pleasure - rider 9 years old or younger, must be accompanied by an adult and the horse/poney to be 14 hands and under.

25. Youth Western Pleasure – Rider 10 years old or older.

26. Adult Western Pleasure – Rider 18 years old or older.

27. Novice (PeeWee) Western Horsemanship - rider 9 years old or younger, must be accompanied by an adult and the horse/poney to be 14 hands and under.

28. Youth Western Horsemanship – Rider 10 years old or older.

29. Adult Western Horsemanship – Rider 18 years old or older.

30. Novice (Peewee) barrels (jog/walk) – rider 9 years old or younger, must be accompanied by an adult and the horse/poney to be 14 hands and under.

31. Youth Barrels (Trot/Canter) – Rider 10 years old and older.

32. Open Barrels – Rider 18 years old or older.

33. Novice (PeeWee) Pole Bending - rider 9 years old or younger, must be accompanied by an adult and the horse/poney to be 14 hands and under.

34. Youth Pole Bending – Rider 10 years old or older.

35. Adult Pole Bending – Rider 18 years old or older.

36. Musical Stalls - No Age restriction MUST be able to walk/trot/canter be able to get on and off without Assistance.
