

ATTENTION ALL CATTLE (BEEF) EXHIBITORS

- Open to exhibitors from all regions
- -All exhibitors must become members of the Pontiac Agricultural Society.
- **-Every exhibitor is required to forward with their entry form a certificate of proof of liability insurance for the current year (minimum of \$1,000,000 is required) and membership fee.**
- **Entries will not be processed until this information is received.**
- **Entries are to be sent to Pontiac Agricultural Society, Box 149, Shawville QC J0X 2Y0. Entries must be received in the Fair office. August 27th 2021. Entries on AssisExpo by August 27th 2021.**
- -Entry fee: 15% complete of prize money won by the exhibitor.
- -Protests shall be lodged with the Director of the division or the Fair office on the day of show. All protests must be made in writing and accompanied by \$100.00 cash or a certified cheque payable to Pontiac Agricultural Society. The director's decision is final. No protest shall impede the schedule of the show or flow of classes.
- -It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall so hold the Pontiac Agricultural Society and/or the committee blameless for any loss or accident. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall be responsible for any injury or damage that may be occasioned to any person or thing whomever or whatever against all claims or demands for loss or damage occasioned thereby.
- -Children under the age of 6 years will not be allowed in any of the livestock buildings unless accompanied by an adult.
- -Animals showing signs of contagious diseases or parasite infections – i.e. IBR, lice, will not be allowed to remain on the grounds.
- -Pontiac Agricultural Society is not liable for any diseases passed from animals at the Fair.
- -All animals must have Quebec ATQ tags or Ontario identification tags. If an animal does not have proper identification tags, the animal in question will be asked to leave the grounds.
- -Passes are allotted as: helper – 2 passes for every 4 head. The passes will be distributed once checked by one of the Directors.
- -In order to have access to the restricted zone during livestock shows, all livestock exhibitors and helpers will be required to wear a unique wristband to identify them to Security. The wristband will be issued by the Director of the division.
- A maximum of 10 classes per breed to be shown
- Two substitution will be allowed
- There is no restriction on multiple exhibits in any classes, excluding the breeder's herd and get of sire. The number of entries per exhibitor is limited to a maximum often.
- Calves shown in cow/calf pairs may be shown individually.
- Prior to set-up of clipping crates, please contact the Director in Charge as to the correct location.

ATTENTION ALL BEEF EXHIBITORS COVID RULES

All exhibitors, helpers and spectators must respect guidelines from Santé publique du Québec. The COVID rules for the show details are **subject to approval and recommendation from Santé publique du Québec. We will keep you updated in a timely manner** of any changes to these rules.

- **We recommend** that you and your helpers **get your second dose of vaccine** at least two weeks **before the Shawville Fair.**
- **We will be respecting all social distancing rules as required in the barns and show ring.**
- **Exhibitors must provide names and contact information for all helpers.**
- Barns are closed to the general public.
- In order to allow the most distance between individuals, **all exhibitors are asked not to store feed, bedding, implements or chairs in the walkways or in front of the barn doors.**
- Parking for trailers is permitted on the fair grounds for this year.

NEW FOR 2021

- **No ribbons or banners will be awarded this year, but prize money remains the same.**
- Exhibitors must arrive before show time and remain until the show is over.
- **The show will begin at 11 AM. The show order may change due to number of entries but will be in alphabetical order. One breed class after the other ie Angus, Bull calf, Charolais calf, etc.**
- Barns will be open for exhibitors to tie in.
- Stalls will be allotted as to the date of the entry arrival at the office
- Prior to the set-up of clipping crates, please contact the Director in charge as to the correct location
- Note: No bedding of stalls is allowed until the barn superintendent has allotted them.

9. Breeder's Herd. A group of four (4) animals bred by the exhibitor, both sexes represented, must have shown in previous classes. At least one (1) animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one (1) exhibit per exhibitor.

10. Get of sire. A group of three (3) animals from the same sire, both sexes represented, must have shown in previous classes. At least one (1) animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one (1) exhibit per exhibitor.

11. Progeny of dam. Two (2) animals the progeny of one dam, must have shown in previous classes. Limited to one (1) exhibit per exhibitor.

ANY OTHER BREED OR CROSSBRED CLASSES

56-1. Any other breed or Crossbred heifer born in 2021.

56-2. Any other breed or Crossbred heifer born in 2020.
