ATTENTION ALL 4-H STEER FINISHING CLUB EXHIBITORS COVID RULES

All details are subject to approval and recommendation from Santé Publique Québec. We will keep you updated in a timely manner.

- We recommend that you and your helpers get your second dose of vaccine before the Shawville Fair.
- We will be respecting all social distancing rules as required in the barns and show ring. Exhibitors are responsible for providing names and contact information for all helpers.
- Barns are open to exhibitors and helpers only, no general public allowed inside
- In order to allow distancing all exhibitors are ask not to store feed, bedding, implements or chairs in the walkways or in front of the barn doors.
- Parking for trailers is permitted on the fair grounds for this year.
- No ribbons or banners will be awarded this year, but prize money remains the same.
- Arrive no later than Thursday 1 PM and remain until the show is over.
- The show will be on the Friday, the show order may change due to number of entries.

ALL SHOWS ARE IN AN OUTDOOR RING Please be prepared for all kinds of weather

Rules:

-Please see and follow "Attention All Cattle Exhibitors".

-Every exhibitor is required to forward with their entry form a certificate of proof of liability insurance for the current year (minimum of \$1,000,000 is required) and membership fee. Entries will not be processed until this information is received and will be subject to late entry fee of 25% of gross prize money. Entries are to be sent to Pontiac Agricultural Society, Box 149, Shawville QC J0X 2Y0. Entries must be received in the Fair office or postmarked by August 11, 2017.

-Steer project must be registered with the Shawville Fair steer Director. Registration will be by entry form and paid Pontiac Agricultural Society membership and 4-H dues.

-ATQ tag number must be provided upon registration.

-Each member will be allowed one "spare" steer, as long as it is pre-registered by registration form indicating ATQ number. A "spare" steer must be housed with and managed in the same manner as the exhibitor's main 4-H project. A group of steer club members whose steers are housed together may share a common "spare" steer, or each pre-register one specific spare steer as long as their intentions are indicated by registration form. A steer club member must exhibit either his/her main 4-H project or the spare steer they have pre-registered. It is not mandatory for a steer club member to have a "spare" steer.

-Steers and "spare" steers must be available for inspection at all times.

-Steers must be on the Fair grounds by Thursday at 1:00 p.m. Steers arriving late will be penalized a shrink of 1% body weight for each hour late of indicated time.

-Steers will be weighed Thursday 6:30 p.m.

-Exhibitor will be paid for 1,300 pounds maximum.

-Exhibitor must attend a combination of four (4) 4-H and/or steer club meetings in the current year.

-All animals are the responsibility of the exhibitor until removed from fair grounds.

-All animals deemed to be a safety hazard by the committee will not be permitted to show and/or be sold.

-All steers must be finished in order to sell in the sale.

-All steers shown must be sold by auction. The order of sale will be determined by the steer Director.

-Each exhibitor must show in both his/her breed and showmanship classes. Any exhibitor failing to do so will be disqualified and will not be awarded any prize money, trophies, points or recognition for his/her show. Those not following this rule will be asked to remove their calf/steer from the grounds. This rule applies to both 4-H calf and steer projects. Steer exhibitors not abiding by this rule will also forfeit their opportunity to participate in the steer sale. If an amendment to the rules for showmanship is necessary for safety reasons, the decision to exempt the exhibitor will be made jointly by the Pontiac Agricultural Society Director of the 4-H division, the 4-H Club leader of the show and the Pontiac Agricultural Society President.
