ATTENTION JUNIOR EXHIBITORS COVID RULES

All details are subject to approval and recommendation from Santé Publique Québec. We will keep you updated in a timely manner.

- We recommend that you and your helpers get your second dose of vaccine, if applicable, before the Shawville Fair.
- We will be respecting all social distancing rules as required in the barns and show ring. Exhibitors are responsible for providing names and contact information for all helpers.
- Barns are open to exhibitors and helpers only, no general public allowed inside
- In order to allow distancing all exhibitors are ask not to store feed, bedding, implements or chairs in the walkways or in front of the barn doors.
- Parking for trailers is permitted on the fair grounds for this year.
- Some ribbons or banners will be awarded this year, but prize money remains the same.
- Arrive before show time and remain until the show is over.

ALL SHOWS ARE IN AN OUTDOOR RING Please be prepared for all kinds of weather

Rules:

-Every exhibitor is required to forward with their entry form a certificate of proof of liability insurance for the current year (minimum of \$1,000,000 is required), copy of negative coggins test for the period of two years preceding the first day of the Fair, and membership fee. Entries will not be processed until this information is received, and will be subject to late entry fee of 25% of gross prize money. Entries are to be sent to Pontiac Agricultural Society, Box 149, Shawville QC J0X 2Y0. Entries must be received in the Fair office or postmarked by August 11, 2017.

-Competitors must be between the ages of 6 and 25 years, inclusive, as of January 1st of the current year.

-Members must be in good standing with the club constitution (meetings, membership, project papers, etc.), at the discretion of the club.

-Animals may be grade or purebred females. Contestants must train their own project.

-Competitors in steer, calf, horse, sheep, rabbit, poultry, horticulture and craft classes must decide by the Thursday at 8:00 p.m. which class will be counted for points and give their decision to the overall club leader.

-All members' trophies must be taken to the Shawville Fair office before the current year in order for the member to be eligible to participate in the show. NO EXCEPTIONS.

-Each Exhibitor must show in both his/her breed and showmanship classes. Any Exhibitor failing to do so will be disqualified and will not be awarded any prize money, trophies, points or recognition for his/her show. Those not following this rule will be asked to remove their calf, steer, horse, sheep from the grounds. This rule applies to 4-H calf, steer, horse and sheep projects. Steer exhibitors not abiding by this rule will also forfeit their opportunity to participate in the steer sale. NO EXCEPTIONS to this rule. If an amendment to the rules for showmanship is necessary for safety reasons, the decision to exempt the exhibitor will be made jointly by the Pontiac Agricultural Society Director of the 4-H division, the 4-H Club leader of the show and the Pontiac Agricultural Society President.

-Pontiac Agricultural Society reserves the right to cancel/group the inter-club classes should less than three animals make entries. All entries must be on the grounds by 8:00 a.m. Saturday. Members are requested to bring all requirements for preparing animals for the show.

-All decisions of the show committee are final.

-The committee shall not be responsible for any articles lost or stolen, sickness or other accidents that may happen to the contestants during their stay at the Fair.

-Members of the 4-H club must purchase Pontiac Agricultural Society memberships at the Fair office in order to be eligible to participate in the regional show on Saturday. If 4-H members wish to show in an open show (i.e. beef, dairy, poultry, horse) they must purchase a regular membership.

Showmanship:

Contestants must be 25 years and under as of January 1st of the current year and will be judged on:

-Neatness of contestant (dress in white for dairy; white shirt and black pants for beef, must wear appropriate boots)

-Condition of calf, cleanliness, training, fitness, etc.

-Presentation in ring, showing manners, suitable halter (rope or leather)

Points awarded as follows: 90 for 1st place, 80 for 2nd, decreasing by 10 points until 50 points. All remaining competitors will receive 50 points. Grand Champion Showperson (beef and dairy) receives 10 bonus points, Reserve Grand Champion Showperson (beef and dairy) receives 5 bonus points.
