Regulations:

-Sheep must arrive no later than 8:30 a.m. on Show Day.

-Release time will be 4:00 p.m. on show day providing the show has concluded. \*If the show has not concluded, release time will be one half hour following the end of the show.

-Every exhibitor is required to forward with their entry form a certificate of proof of liability insurance for the current year (minimum of \$1,000,000 is required) and membership fee. Entries will not be processed until this information is received, and will be subject to a late entry fee of 25% of gross prize money. Entries are to be sent to Pontiac Agricultural Society, Box 149, Shawville QC J0X 2Y0. Entries must be received in the Fair office or postmarked by August 11, 2017.

-Entry fee: 15% of prize money won by the exhibitor.

-Any animals showing evidence of contagious disease will be removed from the housing and show areas at the request of the Pontiac Agricultural Society - Shawville Fair Sheep Committee. If these animals are deemed eligible for the show by a veterinarian (on the day of the show at the owner's expense) these animals will be allowed to be shown.

-All sheep must bear approved CLIA identification tags and in the case of Quebec housed sheep, ATQ tags are required.

-The Sheep Committee retains the right to combine breed classes together if numbers warrant. If there are less than 2 breeders in a class, that class will be combined with the "Any other breeds" class.

-An exhibitor may show a maximum of 6 head per breed and a maximum of 2 in any one section for individual animals.

-Exhibitors must follow a dress code for single classes – black pants and white shirt.

-Helper passes will be given as follows, and are only for entry to the fair grounds: 1 pass per 6 head.
