Rules:

- Please see and follow "Attention All Horsemen".
- **Every Exhibitor is required to forward with their entry form a certificate of proof of liability insurance for the current year (minimum of \$2,000,000 is required).**
- Entries may be done online at AssistExpo or sent to the Pontiac Agricultural Society, Box 149, Shawville, QC J0X 2Y0. Entries must be received in the Fair Office by August 16, 2026.
- Entry fee: 15% of prize money won by Exhibitor.

- Late entry fee of 25% of gross prize money.
- All driven entries must have another capable driver with them.
- Use correct exhibitor number for each animal, to avoid errors with results.
- Hitch horses have priority in the heavy horse barn.
- Due to the volume of animals, loading and unloading will be at the side or back of the heavy horse barn.
- Passes are allotted as: helper - 1 helper pass for every 2 horses; vehicle - 6 helper passes for 6 horses, **second and third vehicles must park off-site. Passes will be mailed out to all exhibitors with entries in before deadline.**
- Due to the limited parking, spaces will be assigned. Please see the Director before parking. All unnecessary trailers and vehicles will be directed to off site parking once animals and supplies are unloaded. **1 camper per Exhibitor may be parked on the fairgrounds, additional campers to park in the camper lot across Clarendon St. free of charge.**

Travel Compensation

Exhibitors traveling **74 km or less** (one way) from the Exhibitor's farm address to the Shawville Fairgrounds located at 215 Lang Street, Shawville, Quebec, will receive **\$25 per animal exhibited to a maximum of \$250**

Exhibitors traveling **75 km or more** (one way) from the Exhibitor's farm address to the Shawville Fairgrounds located at 215 Lang Street, Shawville, Quebec, will receive **\$50 per animal exhibited to a maximum of \$500**
