

## ATTENTION ALL BEEF EXHIBITORS

- Open to exhibitors from all regions
- All exhibitors must become members of the Pontiac Agricultural Society
- **Every exhibitor is required to forward with their entry form a certificate of proof of liability insurance for the current year (minimum of \$2,000,000 is required) and membership fee. Entries are to be sent to Pontiac Agricultural Society, Box 149, Shawville QC J0X 2Y0. Entries must be received in the Fair office or postmarked by August 14, 2026. Entries on AssitExpo by August 26, 2026.**
- Entry fee: 15% of prize money won by the exhibitor.
- Protests shall be lodged with the Director of the division or the Fair office on the day of show. All protests must be made in writing and accompanied by \$100 cash or a certified cheque payable to Pontiac Agricultural Society. The director's decision is final. No protest shall impede the schedule of the show or flow of classes.
- It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Pontiac Agricultural Society and/or the committee blameless for any loss or accident. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall be responsible for any injury or damage that may be occasioned to any person or thing whomever or whatever against all claims or demands for loss or damage occasioned thereby.
- Animals showing signs of contagious diseases or parasite infections – i.e. IBR, lice, will not be allowed to remain on the grounds.
- Pontiac Agricultural Society is not liable for any diseases passed from animals at the Fair.
- All animals must have Quebec ATQ tags or Ontario identification tags. If an animal does not have proper identification tags, the animal in question will be asked to leave the grounds.
- Passes are allotted as: helper – 2 passes for every 4 head; vehicle – 1 pass per exhibitor, over 6 head 2nd vehicle pass is off-site. Passes will be distributed after animals have been checked in by the Director.
- There are no restrictions on multiple exhibits in any classes, excluding the breeders herd and get of sire and progeny of dam.
- Calves shown in cow/calf pairs may be shown individually
- For Friday arrival, please inform Directors by Thursday morning.
- Exhibitors arrive Saturday morning and leave when show is finished.
- **The show order may change due to the number of entries but will be in alphabetical order. One breed class after the other i.e; Angus, Bull calf, Any Other Breed or Crossbreed, Bull calf, etc**
- Prior to set-up of clipping crates, please contact the Director in charge as to the correct location.
- Any classes with more than 14 entries may be split at judges discretion. Calf classes will be split by age if over 10 entries.
- Free bedding (bark) will be supplied to all Exhibitors.
- **Any animal with no registration number will be entered in the Any Other Breed/Crossbreed class.**

2. To participate in a CHA MOE show, the owner, not necessarily the handler of an animal, must be a member in good standing of the Canadian Hereford Association.
3. A digital copy of the registration certificate must accompany entries. Exhibitors are reminded that entries must be made in the exact ownership as it appears on the pedigree entry, all animals must have a legible tattoo corresponding with the pedigree

4. No tattoo altering will be allowed after arrival
5. Exhibitors must have stall cards for each animal.
6. The red show vest or shirt must be worn by all exhibitors.

10.MATURE COW Born prior to January 1<sup>st</sup> 2024 with her own 2026 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Female and calf shall be shown as a unit, except that the calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in classes 1,5, 11,12 & 13. The calf does not accumulate MOE show points for itself.

11.BREEDER`S HERD – A group of four(4) animals bred by the exhibitor, both sexes represented, must have shown in previous classes. At least one (1) animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one(1) exhibit per exhibitor. A cow/calf pair is one female unit and cannot be split to make another unit in the class. A bull calf can be one unit in the Breeder's class, but then his mother cannot be entered in the class

12. GET OF SIRE – A group of three (3) animals from the same sire, both sexes represented, must have shown in previous classes. At least one (1) animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one (1) exhibit per exhibitor

13. Progeny of Dam - Two(2) animals the progeny of one dam, must have been shown in previous classes. Limited to one (1) exhibit per exhibitor

## **PREMIER BREEDER AWARD**

- As quoted from the Canadian Hereford Association Mark of Excellence Regulations. An award will be presented to the individual or company (as recorded on the Certificate or Registration) whose animals accumulate the highest total points based on their highest six (6) placings in the individual classes, To be eligible for the Premier Breeder Award, the breeder must exhibit at the show. Qualification for this award is based on Canadian rules that specify all owners at the time of conception are breeders of the animals.

## **PREMIER EXHIBITOR AWARD**

- An award will be presented to the exhibitor with the most points for animals owned and shown by the exhibitor based on their highest six(6) placings in the individual classes. All animals accumulating points for this award must be the entries of one exhibitor. In the case of a joint ownership, the exhibitor must be specified, otherwise the joint owners will be considered as one exhibitor as one exhibitor/entity.
