

PONTIAC AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY (PAS)

SHAWVILLE FAIR CAMPGROUND RULE

To ensure a safe, enjoyable, and family-friendly environment for everyone, all campers and guests must comply with the following campground rules.

Registration & Campsites

- Campsites are **un-serviced** (no electricity, water, or sewer connections).
- One (1) RV or trailer is permitted per campsite.
- One (1) vehicle is permitted per campsite.
- Camping permits are sold **per campsite**, not per person, and **do not include admission to the Shawville Fair**.
- Each campsite must have **at least one registered occupant who is 18 years of age or older**. Campsites occupied only by minors are prohibited.
- Camping permits are **non-transferable**.
- Campsites are for **RVs and trailers only**. Tents are not permitted.
- Management reserves the right to refuse admission or remove any camper who fails to comply with campground rules.

Safety & Security

1. All vehicles, RVs, trailers, and personal property may be subject to inspection before entering the campground.
2. The maximum speed limit throughout the campground is **8 km/h**.
3. Quiet hours are in effect from **1:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.**
 - Excessive noise, loud music, loud voices, vehicle stereos, or the operation of non-inverter generators during quiet hours is prohibited.
 - A first violation will result in a warning. A second violation may result in immediate removal from the campground without refund.
4. Roadways and emergency access routes must remain clear at all times. Vehicles must be parked only within their assigned campsite.
5. Campers are responsible for keeping their campsite clean and free of garbage. Please dispose of waste in designated receptacles.

6. Dumping of wastewater, grey water, or sewage anywhere on the grounds is strictly prohibited.
7. Open fires, campfires, charcoal fires, and wood-burning appliances are prohibited. Approved propane fire pits and propane cooking appliances are permitted where allowed by local fire regulations.
8. Every RV or trailer should be equipped with a working smoke detector and fire extinguisher.
9. Glass bottles and glass containers are discouraged and may be prohibited in designated areas for safety reasons.
10. Following the closure of the Fair each evening, **only registered campers** will be permitted to enter the campground.
11. Security personnel patrol the campground throughout the night. Please report any emergencies, suspicious activity, unsafe behaviour, or violations of campground rules to Security immediately.

Conduct

- The Shawville Fair maintains **zero tolerance** for:
 - Fighting or violent behaviour;
 - Harassment, abusive, threatening, or disrespectful conduct;
 - Vandalism or destruction of property;
 - Illegal activities;
 - Failure to comply with the directions of PAS Directors, campground staff, security personnel, or law enforcement.
- Unruly or disruptive campers may be removed immediately without refund.
- The Pontiac Agricultural Society reserves the right to take any action reasonably necessary to protect the safety, security, and enjoyment of campers, guests, volunteers, employees, exhibitors, and Fair property.

Liability

- Campers are responsible for the conduct of all members of their party and any visitors to their campsite.
- The Pontiac Agricultural Society is not responsible for loss, theft, damage to property, accidents, or injuries occurring within the campground.
